

**EXPECTATIONS**

1. To be on time and ready to work. (with text book, notebook, pencil, paper, etc.)
2. A **3-ring binder** with dividers is necessary to keep all work organized.
3. Expect that homework will be assigned daily. Assignments are to be completed by the beginning of the next class. Parents will be notified if a student is not consistently doing homework.
4. Make up all class work missed due to absence within 1 day upon return. Quizzes and tests are to be made up within one week upon return. It is your responsibility to schedule make up work. If you know ahead about an absence, please let me know.
5. Get extra help, when needed, as soon as possible.
6. Be respectful to everyone in the classroom by keeping language and comments appropriate.
7. Allow others to learn.
8. Respect school and others' property. ( DO NOT WRITE on desks, books, calculators, ...\_
9. Follow school rules.  
NO electronic devices in class. This includes cell phones, CD players, MP3 players, Ipod's, etc.
10. Tardies - Teacher detention on the 3<sup>rd</sup> tardy and all subsequent tardies to reflect the time missed. Parents will be notified. On the 6<sup>th</sup> tardy, the administration will be informed through a referral.
11. Food and drink may be brought to class and eaten during the beginning of the block. **Students are not** to leave class to get or purchase food after the block begins. This privilege may be revoked.
